### **Dennis Schindel, Director of Audit**

#### **Palm Beach County Office of Inspector General**

Mr. Schindel is the Director of Audit for the Palm Beach County Inspector General's Office. He has been in this position since June of 2011 and is responsible for establishing and managing the OIG's audit program. Mr. Schindel has over 35 years of government auditing experience. Prior to joining the Palm Beach County Office of Inspector General, Mr. Schindel worked 21 years for the U.S. Treasury Office of Inspector General. Mr. Schindel served in the Treasury OIG, first as the Assistant Inspector General for Audit (AIGA) and then as the Deputy Inspector General. As AIGA, he was responsible for directing all audits of Treasury programs and operations. During his time as AIGA he established one of the strongest financial statement auditing capabilities in the federal IG community. Mr. Schindel served 10 years as Treasury's Deputy Inspector General responsible for managing both the audit and investigations functions. During that time he twice acted for one year periods as the Treasury Inspector General. Under his leadership, Treasury OIG quickly and effectively re-focused its audit and investigation resources to address major issues facing the Treasury Department resulting from the 2008 financial crisis, including reviews and investigations of failed financial institutions regulated by Treasury. Prior to joining the Treasury OIG, Mr. Schindel had a successful career as an internal auditor with the Internal Revenue Service.

He is a Certified Internal Auditor, a Certified Inspector General and a graduate of Villanova University with a B.S. degree in Accounting.
