

BROWARD OIG SENIOR AUDITOR

The Broward Office of the Inspector General is seeking an auditor to complement its staff. The Broward OIG's mission is to promote integrity and accountability in Broward County by investigating allegations of misconduct, including fraud, corruption and abuse, and gross mismanagement. As part of an investigation, the OIG may audit any program, contract, or the operations of any division, department, or office of the county or municipalities, as well as the operations or performance of any provider as it relates to its contract with the county or municipality. The Senior Auditor's work involves the examination and evaluation of management activities to help ensure the reliability and integrity of information; compliance with policies, plans, procedures, laws and regulations; the safeguarding of assets; the economical and efficient use of resources; and the accomplishment of established goals and management objectives.

The OIG Senior Auditor must have a minimum of four-year college or university studies with major course work in accounting and some course work in basic management principles, as well as three (3) years experience in accounting or auditing work. A professional certification as a Certified Public Accountant (CPA), a Certified Internal Auditor (CIA), or Certified Information Systems Auditor (CISA) is preferred. Experience in conducting audits of construction activity and identifying cost recovery opportunities is preferred.

Salary is commensurate with education and experience, ranging between \$64,714.90 and \$100,785.50. An attractive benefits package, including participation in the Florida Retirement System is also included.
