Eric Miller currently serves as the Chief Inspector General for Governor Rick Scott. In this role, Chief Miller serves as the inspector general for the Executive Office of the Governor and provides direction and guidance to the inspectors general currently serving in various state agencies that report directly to Governor Scott.

Chief Miller entered public service in 1982 with the City of Pensacola. While there, Chief Miller served several roles including uniformed police officer, motorcycle officer, TAC Unit officer, Major Crimes Control Division investigator, drug enforcement detective, police field trainer, and academy instructor. In 1993, Chief Miller entered state service as a lieutenant with the Office of Inspector General for the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, eventually commanding that same unit.

In 2001, Chief Miller assumed a leadership role at the Department of Insurance, directing the operations of the Bureau of Fire and Arson Investigations for the Division of the State Fire Marshal. In 2004, Chief Miller was asked by Florida's first Chief Financial Officer to serve as the Director of the Division of Insurance Fraud, the criminal justice agency responsible for the investigation of insurance fraud, title fraud, insurance related crimes, and other financial crimes in the State of Florida. Chief Miller served in that role until 2007 when he was tapped to lead the Divisions of State Fire Marshal, Insurance Fraud, and Worker Compensation as the Deputy Chief Financial Officer for Compliance and Enforcement.

Chief Miller later went on to serve as Chief Compliance Manager for Citizens Property Insurance Corporation and Inspector General at the Agency for Health Care Administration, where he also oversaw the Medicaid Program Integrity unit, whose primary focus is identifying potential overbilling and fraudulent activity within the state's Medicaid program.

Chief Miller resides in Tallahassee with his wife, the former Gina Grant, and their two sons, Andrew and Aiden.
